PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending further the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1925 (No. 17 of 1925), as amended by Proclamation No. 48 of 1929.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation 1925 (No. 17 of 1925) as amended by Proclamation No. 48 of 1929 hereinafter referred to as the "said Proclamation."

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *eleven* of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by the addition of the following new sub-section:—
 - (3) In the case of a conviction of any person for a contravention of sub-sections (1) and (2) of this section the Court may in addition to any other penalty imposed order the confiscation of any fire-arms and ammunition found in the possession of the accused at the time of the commission of the offence of which he has been convicted. The Resident Commissioner shall authorize the disposal of such arms and ammunition in any manner he may think fit.
2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
