PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending further the law relating to the exportation of cattle from the Bechuanaland Protectorate and providing for the imposition of fees for weighing any cattle whether exported from the territory or not.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the law relating to the exportation of cattle from the Bechuanaland Protectorate (herein after referred to as "the territory") and to provide for the imposition of fees for weighing any cattle whether exported from the territory or not;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I hereby declare, proclaim, and make known as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the High Commissioner from time to time by notice in the *Gazette* to make, alter, and repeal regulations for all or any of the following purposes, and to provide penalties for the contravention thereof:—

- (1) The restriction of the export from the territory of horned cattle; *or other stock*
- (2) The imposition of fees for weighing horned cattle; *or other stock*
- (3) The imposition of fees for supervising the branding and trucking of horned cattle and sealing of trucks containing such cattle, *or other stock*

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation of Cattle Amendment Proclamation, 1930, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
