PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Repealing certain Proclamations promulgated for the Bechuanaland Protectorate which have become obsolete and amending other Proclamations in force in the said Protectorate.

Whereas it is expedient to repeal certain Proclamations promulgated for the Bechuanaland Protectorate which have become obsolete, and to amend other Proclamations in force in the said Protectorate.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Proclamations enumerated in the first column of the Schedule hereto attached are hereby repealed or amended as set forth opposite each such Proclamation in the second column of the said Schedule.

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Revision of Laws Proclamation, 1930, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
