PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Bringing into uniformity the legislation of the Bechuanaland Protectorate in regard to the designation of "Resident Magistrate".

Whereas there exists a lack of uniformity in the legislation of the Bechuanaland Protectorate in regard to the designation of "Resident Magistrate,"

And whereas it is desirable that the same designation should be used throughout in regard thereto:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

Wherever the term "Assistant Commissioner" or "Acting Assistant Commissioner" appears in any law referring to the Bechuanaland Protectorate, it shall be read so as to include Resident Magistrate or Acting Resident Magistrate.
