BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 31st October, 1930.)

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled "The Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1930".

Whereas it is expedient to amend further the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation 1922 (No. 70 of 1922), as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal law") and to fix rates of income tax to be levied in the Bechuanaland Protectorate in respect of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1930;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section seven of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "five hundred pounds" where they appear and the substitution therefor of the words "four hundred pounds".

2. In terms of sub-section (3) of section five of the principal law there shall be levied in respect of income as in the said Proclamation defined received by or accrued to or in favour of any person during the year ended the thirtieth day of June, 1930, an income tax at the rates specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) of section one of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation 1927 (No. 31 of 1927).

3. This Proclamation shall be deemed to have been in force as from the first day of July, 1930: provided that the amendment to the principal law contained in this Proclamation shall first take effect in respect of assessments made for the year of assessment ended the thirtieth day of June, 1930.

4. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1930.
