PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Applying the provisions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Reformatories and Prisoners and Juvenile Offenders Removal Proclamation No. 81 of 1921 to the case of persons who have been sentenced to be detained during the High Commissioner's pleasure under Proclamation No. 35 of 1910.

Whereas doubts have arisen as to whether the provisions of Proclamation No. 81 of 1921 are applicable in the case of persons who have been sentenced to be detained during the High Commissioner's pleasure under Proclamation No. 35 of 1910 and it is expedient to remove such doubts.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. (1) Where under the provisions of section *one* of Proclamation No. 35 of 1910 a person has been sentenced to be detained during the High Commissioner's pleasure the High Commissioner may direct that such person shall be detained in a juvenile reformatory.

(2) Where the High Commissioner has directed that any person to whom sub-section (1) applies shall be detained in a juvenile reformatory, the provisions of Proclamation No. 81 of 1921 shall in all respects apply to such person as if he had been sentenced by a Court under section *two* of that Proclamation to be detained in a juvenile reformatory.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the Bechuanaland Protectorate Reformatories and Prisoners and Juvenile Offenders Removal Proclamation, No. 81 of 1921, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
