## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Schedule to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Patents Registration Proclamation 1920 (No. 30 of 1920) is hereby amended by the addition of the following item at the end thereof:

7. On enlargement of time for payment of renewal fees:—

Not exceeding one month ... ..	£1 0 0
Not exceeding two months ... ..	£2 0 0
Not exceeding three months ... ..	£3 0 0

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation No. 30 of 1920 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
