

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

MOTOR ROADS.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section *fourteen*, sub-sections (1) and (3) of Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, I do prohibit the use of motor cars and lorries which with their load exceed 4,000 lbs. in weight upon those portions of the public road hereinafter described and do declare the said portions of the road to be a motor road, namely:—

From the Notice Boards "Motor Cars only" and "Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lbs. prohibited on this road" near the bottom of the hill about half a mile south of Lobatsi to the Notice Boards "For Motor Cars only" and "Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lbs. prohibited on this road" near the gate where the road to Mafeking branches away from the Lobatsi—Kanye road, and from those Notice Boards to similar ones at the gate leading into the Bangwaketse Reserve about five miles west of Lobatsi.

This Notice to take effect from the 1st January, 1932.
