

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 113 of 1931.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926 (No. 4 of 1926), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel section *sixteen* of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 28 of 1926 and to substitute therefor the following new section:—

16. The Resident Commissioner may for the purpose of preventing the introduction or spread of any disease order any stock to be moved to any place from any other place, or isolated in such manner and under such conditions as he may prescribe in consultation with the Chief Veterinary Officer. He may also prohibit in any district or portion thereof the holding of exhibitions of stock and the sale of stock on public markets and in private sale-yards.
