

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 53 OF 1931.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* (2) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, No. 4 of 1926, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

1. The introduction into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Southern Rhodesia of all animal products, including hides, skins, horns, hoofs, wool, hair, feathers, milk, cream, blood, meat and manure, is prohibited until further notice.

2. The introduction into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Southern Rhodesia of all vegetable products, including grass, grass-hay, straw, lucern hay, mealies, mealie-stalks, cobs, kaffir-corn and stalks, is prohibited except by special permission of the Resident Commissioner.
