RATES OF POSTAGE AND OTHER CHARGES.

1. Letters.....	2d. for the first ounce and 1d. per ounce thereafter.
2 (a) Postcards (single).....	1d. each.
(b) Postcards (reply paid)	2d. each.
3 (a) Accounts, Receipts & Invoices	1d. for the first 4 ounces and $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per 2 ounces thereafter.
