PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Providing for the prohibition, control or regulation of the importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate of wheaten flour and wheaten meal.

Whereas it is desirable to provide for the prohibition, control or regulation of the importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate of wheaten flour and wheaten meal;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The High Commissioner may, from time to time, by notice in the *Gazette* prohibit, control or regulate the importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate of wheaten flour and wheaten meal, or any class of wheaten flour or wheaten meal.

2. The High Commissioner may make all such regulations as he may deem necessary or expedient for the carrying out of any prohibition, control or regulation imposed under section *one*.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Flour and Meal Importation Restriction Proclamation 1931 and shall have force and take effect from the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
