PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending Tariff 15 of the Second Schedule of Act No. 20 of 1884 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope as in force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is desirable to amend Tariff 15 of the Second Schedule of Act No. 20 of 1884 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope as in force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate (hereinafter called the Principal Law);

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Law there shall be paid to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration yearly as from the 1st day of January, 1932, by all dealers in gunpowder the sum of £7. 10s. for a licence to deal in gunpowder.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the Principal Law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
