### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending in certain respects Proclamation No. 23 of 1930 which regulates the export or removal from the Bechuanaland Protectorate of goods and live stock from Southern Rhodesia.

Whereas it is desirable to amend in certain respects Proclamation No. 23 of 1930 (hereinafter called the Principal Law);

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

- (1) Section *five* of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "The Cattle Purchase for Export Proclamation, No. 36 of 1911", in the first paragraph thereof, and the insertion of the words "The Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1923" between the words "under" and "or any amendment thereof".
- (2) This Proclamation shall be read as one with the Principal Law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
