

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Fixing the rates of Income Tax to be levied in the Bechuanaland Protectorate in respect of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1931.

Whereas it is expedient to fix the rates of Income Tax to be levied in the Bechuanaland Protectorate in respect of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June 1931;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. In terms of sub-section (3) of section *five* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation 1922 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") there shall be levied in respect of income (as in the said Proclamation defined) received by or accrued to or in favour of any person during the year ended the thirtieth day of June, 1931, an income tax at the rates specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation 1927.

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation 1931, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
