PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Amending the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate)
Proclamation, 1929.

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1929 (hereinafter called the Principal Proclamation):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Schedule to the Principal Proclamation is hereby repealed and the following Schedule is substituted therefor:—

SCHEDULE.

For a motor-cycle without sidecar	£0 15 0
For a motor-cycle with sidecar	1 2 6
For a motor-car other than a motor-cycle—	
weighing 1,500 lb. or under	2 5 0
weighing over 1,500 lb. and not exceeding 2,500 lb.	3 0 0
weighing over 2,500 lb. and not exceeding 4,000 lb.	4 10 0
weighing over 4,000 lb. and not exceeding 6,000 lb.	7 10 0
weighing over 6,000 lb. and not exceeding 8,000 lb.	15 0 0
weighing over 8,000 lb. and not exceeding 9,000 lb.	22 10 0
weighing over 9,000 lb.	27 10 0

2. Sub-section (2) of section *four* of the Principal Proclamation is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “ five shillings ” and “ ten shillings ” and the substitution therefor of “ ten shillings ” and “ twenty shillings ” respectively.

3. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1929 Further Amendment Proclamation 1931 and shall have force and take effect from the first day of January, 1932.
