PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Further Appropriation (1930-31) Proclamation, 1931.

Whereas it is desirable to make further provision out of the public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate to meet certain additional expenditure incurred during the year ended on the 31st day of March, 1931;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate are hereby charged with a further sum of £5,454. 16s. 6d. (Five thousand Four hundred and Fifty-four pounds Sixteen shillings and sixpence) to meet expenditure incurred during the year which ended on the 31st day of March, 1931, in excess of the amount appropriated for the purpose according to the particulars set forth in the Schedule to this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Further Appropriation (1930-31) Proclamation 1931, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
