

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

MOTOR ROADS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section *fourteen*, sub-sections (1) and (3) of Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, I do prohibit the use of motor-cars which, with their loads, exceed 4,000 lb. in weight, upon those portions of the public road hereinafter described, and do declare the said portion of road to be a motor road, namely:—

From the sign post bearing the notice "Plumtree Motor Road. Motor vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" near the old homestead on Farm No. 146, 15.9 miles north of Tsessebe, to the sign post bearing the notice "Motor Road. Motor Vehicles weighing with load over 4,000 lb. prohibited on this road" half a mile south of the Protectorate-Rhodesia border gate.

This notice to take effect from the Twenty-third day of September, 1932.
