

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE GOVERNMENT.

NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under High Commissioner's Notice No. 17 of 1932, the following areas are declared to be Stock-Free Zones:—

Zone No. 1.—Extending from Border Beacon I to Border Gate on the main road from Francistown to Bulawayo, being the strip bounded on the north by fence between the Tati District and the territory of Southern Rhodesia, on the south by a line running east and west parallel to such fence and at a distance therefrom of one mile, on the west by the Pandamatenka road and on the east by a line extending from the Border Gate mentioned above and running at right angles to the Border fence to meet the line running east and west.

Zone No. 2.—Extending from the Border Gate on the main road from Francistown to Bulawayo to the junction of the Ramaquabane and Shashi Rivers, being a strip five miles in width bounded on the east by the border of the Tati District and the territory of Southern Rhodesia, on the west by a line running north to south along the following points: (1) Perold's old farm to (2) Notice Board (Restricted Area) on the road from Ramaquabane Siding to Mr. Gibben's farm, along this road to (3) its junction with the main road to Bulawayo, along the main road from Bulawayo south to (4) Notice Board (Restricted Area) at point where the road to Mr. Gibben's dam leaves the main Bulawayo road, along road by way of the dam to (5) Lingilile, along the west bank of the Senyowe River and at a distance therefrom of one mile to (6) Police Camp at the junction of the Senyowa and Dekete Rivers, thence to (7) Notice Board (Restricted Area) on the road from Tsamaea Siding to Mr. Hoare's Dairy at Sivas, to (8) Notice Board (Restricted Area) on road from Bosoli Siding to Ramaquabane IV Police Camp, to (9) Notice Board (Restricted Area) on road to Sentube's half a mile west of Sentube's kraal to (10) Notice Board (Restricted Area) on main road to Matsiloye, thence west of Matsiloye Hills to (11) junction of the Tati and Shashi Rivers, on the north by a line running from the Border Gate on the main road from Francistown to Bulawayo to Perold's old farm, and on the south by the Shashi River.

Zone No. 3.—Extending from Matengwe Camp to Border Beacon I, being a strip three miles in width, bounded on the north-east by the fence on the border of the Bechuanaland Protectorate and the territory of Southern Rhodesia, on the south-west by a line running north to south by way of native stads Thibatsile, Nkungwa, Masoa, Olash, Kgosiman, Mwanane and Monyaka, on the north by the Matengwe River, and on the south by a line extending from Monyaka native stad to a point on the Pandamatenka Road one mile south of Border Beacon I and thence to Border Beacon I.
