MOTOR ROADS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section *fourteen*, sub-sections (1) and (3), of Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, I do declare the hereinafter described portion of the Public Road in the Lobatsi District running from Lobatsi to Ramoutsa to be a motor road, namely: From the notice boards bearing the inscriptions "Motor Cars Only" and "Motor vehicles with loads exceeding 4,000 lb. in weight prohibited on this road" erected at a point on the north-east corner of the Athlone Hospital grounds at Lobatsi to similar notice boards erected at the first railway crossing south of Bathoen Siding; and I do prohibit the use of motor cars and motor lorries which with their loads exceed 4,000 lb. in weight upon this motor road.

This Notice takes effect from the ninth day of September, 1932.
