ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS.

36. (1) When a mineral concession is registered in terms of section *four* of the Proclamation, the Registrar shall forthwith notify such registration to the owner of the land over which the concession is granted and shall also publish in the *Gazette* a notice stating that such concession has been registered; such notice shall contain the date of the concession, the names of the original parties thereto, the present holder's name as appears from the documents lodged with the application for registration and a description of the area affected and the rights conferred by the Concession.

(2) No cession of a Mineral Concession made after the date of this Regulation shall be registered unless it be notarially executed.
