

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 177 of 1932.

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

CUSTOMS.

BOUNTY DUMPING DUTY ON CLOTHING FROM
POLAND.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *fifteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation No. 20 of 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that from and after the eighteenth day of November, 1932, there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid on clothing on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Poland a dumping duty equal to the amount of the bounty or subsidy granted to the manufacturers in Poland in respect of complete three-piece suits, jackets, waistcoats, trousers and overcoats.

Provided that such duty shall not exceed one-half of the value of the clothing as defined in section *fourteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, and provided further that such dumping duty shall not be imposed in respect of clothing shipped to the Bechuanaland Protectorate from Poland prior to the above-mentioned date.
