

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 42 of 1932.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926 (No. 4 of 1926), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel section *eleven* of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 28 of 1926 and to substitute in the place thereof the following amended section:—

“ 11. Any stock which shall have come into the territory, whether such stock is driven or is allowed to stray into the territory, except in the manner provided by these regulations, may be slaughtered by order of the Resident Commissioner, or dealt with in whatever manner the Resident Commissioner may prescribe, and the person who shall import or cause such stock to be imported, or allow such stock to stray into the territory, or the person in charge of the same shall be guilty of an offence against these regulations.
