

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 55 OF 1932.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of sections *three* (4) and *fifteen* of the Post Office Administration and Shipping Combinations Discouragement Act, No. 10 of 1911, of the Union of South Africa, as in force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Franking Regulations for the Bechuanaland Protectorate, subjoined to High Commissioner's Notice No. 73 of 1924 by adding the words "Agricultural Adviser and Instructor" to the list of persons entitled, *ex officio*, to frank letters, other documents, and telegrams on the Public Service.
