

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 67 of 1932.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section two of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926 (No. 4 of 1926), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendments in respect of certain Regulations made under the said section and published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 80 of 1926:—

1. Regulation No. 93 is hereby amended by the omission of the words "from the Ngamiland or the Chobe Districts as defined under High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923 or any notice amending that notice (hereinafter referred to as the 'said districts')" and the substitution therefor of the words "any district".

2. Regulation No. 94 is hereby repealed and the following Regulation substituted therefor:—

94. The owner of any cattle intended to be removed from any district for the purpose of export from the territory shall, before the issue of the permit mentioned in the last preceding regulation, bring such cattle to a place to be appointed by the Government Veterinary Officer or any other duly authorized official by whom the permit is to be issued at a reasonable distance from the place where they are kept for inspection by him.

3. In respect of any inspection made under regulation 94 on or after the first day of April, 1932, the provisions of regulation 95 shall apply save that a fee of two shillings shall be imposed in place of the fee of one shilling therein prescribed.
