PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Amending the Motor-car (Bechuanaland Protectorate)
Proclamation, 1929.

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Motor-car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929, which as subsequently amended is hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. ~~Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal law, if the owner of any motor-car who has in his possession a current registration certificate and licence issued in respect of such motor-car in any of the Territories mentioned in sub-section (1) of section five of the principal law bona fide changes his place of residence permanently from any such Territory to the Bechuanaland Protectorate, he shall not be required to register or obtain a licence in respect of his motor-car as in the principal law provided until after the thirty-first day of December of the year in which his place of residence has been so changed or until after the date of the expiry of such certificate and licence as aforesaid whichever be the earlier date if he submits within seven days of his arrival in the Bechuanaland Protectorate such registration certificate and licence issued to him in any such Territory for endorsement by the registering authority of the area in which he intends to reside, and, if so required by the registering authority, furnishes a sworn declaration to the effect that he has bona fide and permanently changed his residence to the Bechuanaland Protectorate. Such registration certificate and licence endorsed as aforesaid shall be valid as if they were issued under the provisions of the principal law until the next succeeding thirty-first day of December or until the date of the expiry of such certificate and licence whichever be the earlier date.~~

2. Sub-section (3) of section two of the principal law is hereby repealed.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Motor-car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Further Amendment Proclamation, 1932, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
