PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Making provision for an increase in the rate of tax payable by natives in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is necessary to make provision for an increase in the rate of tax payable by natives in the Bechuanaland Protectorate under the provisions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Tax Proclamation of 1932 (No. 1 of 1932), hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (1) of section *three* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "one pound five shillings", and the substitution therefor of the words "one pound eight shillings".

2. Sub-section (3) of section *three* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "one pound five shillings" and the words "three pounds fifteen shillings", and the substitution therefor of the words "one pound eight shillings" and "four pounds four shillings" respectively.

3. Sub-section (1) of section *twenty* of the principal law is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "one-fifth" and the substitution therefor of the word "five-twentyeighths".

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Tax Amendment Proclamation 1932, and shall be read as one with the principal law, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of April, 1932.
