PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Amending Proclamation No. 73 of 1921 regulating the manufacture and possession of certain intoxicating liquors in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

—
Whereas it is expedient to amend Proclamation No. 73 of 1921 regulating the manufacture and possession of certain intoxicating liquors known as "Kaffir beer", "Mokolane" and "Khadi" in the Bechuanaland Protectorate (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law).

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "or" before the words "cause to be made" and the insertion after those words of the words "introduce or be in possession of".

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the Principal Law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
