### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Making provision to enable additional officers of the Bechuanaland Protectorate to administer oaths and take affidavits or solemn declarations in all cases where the same may be lawfully administered or taken.

Whereas it is expedient to make provision to enable additional Officers of the Bechuanaland Protectorate to administer oaths and take affidavits or solemn declarations in all cases where the same may be lawfully administered or taken.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *twenty-one* of the High Commissioner's Proclamation of the 10th day of June, 1891, shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "within the limits of the said Order" and the substitution in place thereof of the words "and such other persons within the limits of the said Order as the High Commissioner may from time to time appoint by notice in the *Gazette*."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration of Oaths Proclamation 1932 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
