PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Empowering the High Commissioner to authorize the issue of stamps for postage and revenue purposes for use in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Whereas it is desirable that the High Commissioner be empowered to authorize the issue of stamps for postage and revenue purposes for use in the Bechuanaland Protectorate (hereinafter called "the said Territory") and for that purpose to amend certain Acts of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope in so far as they are in force in the said Territory:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The High Commissioner is hereby empowered to authorize the issue of such stamps for use in the said Territory for postage and revenue purposes as he may consider necessary.

2. Act No. 1 of 1868 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope and section *seven* of Act No. 20 of 1884 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope are hereby declared to be no longer in operation in the said Territory.

3. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Postage and Revenue Stamps (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1932, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
