PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Postponing temporarily the operation of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Currency (Payment to Natives) Proclamation, 1932 (No. 58 of 1932) within the Tati District.

Whereas provision was made by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Currency (Payment to Natives) Proclamation 1932 (No. 58 of 1932) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") that all monetary payments to natives of the Bechuanaland Protectorate (herein after referred to as "the territory") shall only be made in the legal currency of the territory as defined by the said Proclamation;

And whereas the said Proclamation had force and took effect in the territory from the twenty-fifth day of November 1932;

And whereas it is expedient to postpone temporarily the operation of the said Proclamation within the Tati District of the territory;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The operation of the said Proclamation within the Tati District of the territory shall be and is hereby postponed and the said Proclamation shall not have force and take effect within the Tati District until the fifteenth day of January 1933.

2. This Proclamation shall be deemed to have had force and to have taken effect from the twenty-fifth day of November 1932.
