

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

MOTOR ROAD.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section *fourteen*, sub-section (3) of Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, I do declare the hereinafter described portion of the public road from Ramoutsa to Ootsi to be a motor road, namely:—

“ From a point 1/10th of a mile on the southern side of the Taung River at the boards ‘ To Lobatsi ’ and ‘ Motors Only ’, then in a southerly direction running to the West of Ramoutsa Village for a distance of 2 and 1/10th miles to its junction with the Ramoutsa Village-Ootsi waggon road at the boards marked ‘ To Gaberones ’ and ‘ Motors Only ’.”

This notice to take effect from the 1st June, 1934.
