

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that under the power vested in me by sub-section (1) of section *ten* of the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929 (No. 10 of 1929) I have been pleased to fix the rate of speed, which may not be exceeded by any person driving any motor-car as in that Proclamation defined, at 15 miles an hour over the following portion of the public road (motor road) between Molepolole Government Camp, and Mogoditsane Gate, viz. :—

“From a point 100 yards on the north-east of the Government Camp at Molepolole at the danger sign to a point 100 yards on the north-west of the Government Camp at Molepolole at the danger sign.”

Any person who drives a motor vehicle upon such portion of the aforesaid public road at a speed exceeding the rate prescribed will be guilty of an offence, and liable to the penalties provided in the afore-mentioned Proclamation.
