

# BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 29th June, 1934.)

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Further amending Act No. 20 of 1884 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope, as of force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, relating to Stamp Duties and Fees.

Whereas it is desirable further to amend Act No. 20 of 1884 of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope (hereinafter called the "principal law") as of force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate (hereinafter referred to as "the Territory"):

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Schedule to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Stamp Duties and Fees Amendment Proclamation 1931 (No. 29 of 1931) shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words—

" If given for or upon the payment of money of the amount of—

(a) £1 or upwards but not exceeding £5 ... .. 0s. 1d.

(b) Exceeding £5 ... .. 0s. 2d."

and the substitution therefor of the words—

" If given for or upon the payment of money of the amount of £1 or more ... .. 0s. 1d."

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the principal law and may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Stamp Duties and Fees Further Amendment Proclamation 1934 and shall have force and take effect as from the first day of July, 1934.
