PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Amending further the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties (Amendment) Proclamation, 1925, of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, as amended.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties (Amendment) Proclamation, 1925, of the Bechuanaland Protectorate as amended, hereinafter referred to as the "principal law".

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Item 312 (2) of the First Schedule to the principal law shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "and the Imperial Secretary" and the substitution therefor of the words "the Administrative Secretary to the High Commissioner, and the President of the Special Court".

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
