## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Providing for the payment of a pension to Miss Rosalie Honey in respect of her service as a typist in the office of the High Commissioner for South Africa.

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the payment of a pension to Miss Rosalie Honey in respect of her service as a typist in the Office of the High Commissioner for South Africa;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. A pension at the rate of thirty-four pounds thirteen shillings and fourpence per annum shall be and is hereby granted to the said Miss Rosalie Honey as from the sixteenth day of October 1934 inclusive.

2. The said pension shall be payable out of the funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

3. Sections *twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six* and *twenty-seven* of Proclamation No. 24 of 1933 shall apply to the said pension as if the same were a pension granted under the provisions of that Proclamation.

4. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
