PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Amending the Bechuanaland Protectorate Locust Destruction Proclamation, 1923 (No. 45 of 1923).

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Locust Destruction Proclamation 1923 (No. 45 of 1923) (hereinafter referred to as the principal law);

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *four* of the principal law shall be and is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following sub-section:—

(3) No compensation shall be payable by the Administration, the Department or any officer in respect of injury to or loss or destruction of any plant, tree, shrub, crops or vegetation, cattle, sheep, camels, goats, horses, mules, asses, pigs, dogs, and poultry, by the exercise of the powers of this Proclamation or the Regulations promulgated thereunder.

2. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the principal law and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
