PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium
Taxation (Suspension) Proclamation, 1934.

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the suspension of the operation of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation Proclamation, 1934 (No. 25 of 1934) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation");

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section *seven* thereof, the operation of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby suspended until the thirty-first day of December, 1934.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation (Suspension) Proclamation, 1934, and shall be deemed to have had force and to have taken effect from the 1st day of July, 1934.
