

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 39 of 1935.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by Proclamation No. 10 of 1929, His Excellency the High Commissioner has, in terms of section *one* of the said Proclamation, been pleased to proclaim that the area of Francistown in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, bounded on the north by First Street, on the south by Sixth Avenue, on the east by Fourth Street, and on the west by First Street, at the intersection of which said thoroughfares motor signs "speed limit 20 miles" have been fixed, shall be an urban area for the purposes of the said Proclamation.
