

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Providing for the exercise by Dr. H. W. Dyke of an option to receive in respect of his service in the Bechuanaland Protectorate a reduced pension and a gratuity upon his ultimate retirement.

Whereas Hamilton William Dyke, Esquire, a member of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service, failed to exercise, within the prescribed period of twelve months from the date of publication of the *Gazette* in which his appointment as Principal Medical Officer was notified, an option in terms of sub-section (2) of section *one* of Proclamation No. 11 of 1926 (as amended by Proclamation No. 27 of 1926) to receive in respect of his service in the Bechuanaland Protectorate a reduced pension and a gratuity upon his ultimate retirement;

And whereas Proclamation No. 11 of 1926 (as amended) was repealed by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Pensions Proclamation 1933 (No. 24 of 1933) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") and the provisions of sub-section (2) of section *one* thereof were re-enacted in sub-section (1) of section *eight* of the said Proclamation;

And whereas it is expedient to make further provision for the exercise by the said Hamilton William Dyke of the option referred to above;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in section *thirty-three* of the said Proclamation, the provisions of sub-section (1) of section *eight* thereof shall have effect, in so far as concerns the exercise of the *aforementioned* option by the said Hamilton William Dyke as if the 18th day of October, 1929, being the date of publication of the *Gazette* in which his appointment was notified as aforesaid, was the date of publication of this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
