

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 138 of 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations concerning leave for native employees of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration, which were published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 2 of 1928 in the following respect:—

Regulation No. 4 shall be and is hereby cancelled and the following regulation substituted in lieu thereof:—

“4. Occasional leave not exceeding fourteen days per annum may also be granted on full pay by the Head of a Department in cases of native employees of his Department, or in other cases by a District Commissioner of the District in which the native is serving. Leave under this regulation will not be cumulative.”
