CUSTOMS.

ADDITIONAL DUTY ON MULES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, by section three of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925 (Proclamation No. 20 of 1925), as amended, the High Commissioner may by notice in the *Gazette* bring into operation any duty referred to as a suspended duty in the First Schedule to that Proclamation, and that His Excellency has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid with effect from the twenty-third day of July, 1937, a suspended duty at the rate of £4 each, as set forth in item 1 (c) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, on mules when imported into the territory or taken out of bond.
