

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No 173 of 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon him by section *two* of the Fugitive Criminals Surrender Proclamation, 1908, (No. 14 of 1908) by which provision is made for the surrender of fugitive criminals in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to direct that the said Proclamation shall apply in the case of Hungary during the continuance of the Treaty made on the eighteenth day of September, 1936, between His former Majesty King Edward VIII and His Serene Highness the Regent of the Kingdom of Hungary, under which the Bechuanaland Protectorate is to surrender criminals to Hungary in terms of article *one* of the said Treaty.
