

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 18 OF 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following further amendments to the Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 23 of 1926, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 146 of 1933;

1. Regulation No. 55 shall be and is hereby amended by deleting the words "cattle or sheep" and inserting the following words in place thereof:

"stock or vegetable or animal products likely to convey or spread any disease".

2. Regulation No. 56 shall be and is hereby amended by deleting the words "cattle or sheep" and inserting the following words in place thereof:

"stock or vegetable or animal products likely to convey or spread any disease".

3. Regulation No. 57 shall be and is hereby amended by deleting the words "cattle or sheep" wherever they appear and inserting in place thereof the word "stock".

4. Regulations Nos. 58, 60 and 62 shall be and are hereby amended by deleting the word "cattle" wherever it appears and inserting in place thereof the word "stock".

5. Regulation No. 59 shall be and is hereby amended by deleting the word "cattle" and inserting the following words in place thereof:

"stock or vegetable or animal products likely to convey or spread any disease".

6. Regulation No. 61 shall be and is hereby amended by deleting the word "cattle" wherever it appears and inserting in place thereof:

(a) where the word "cattle" first appears the words:—

"stock or vegetable or animal products likely to convey or spread any disease".

(b) in other places the words:—

"stock or vegetable or animal products".
