

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 193 of 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929 (No. 10 of 1929), as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to proclaim the following areas to be urban areas for the purposes of the said Proclamation, namely:—

- (1) the area within a radius of *one mile* from the Post Office at Serowe;
- (2) the area within a radius of *one mile* from the Railway Station at Mahalapye;
- (3) the area within a radius of *half a mile* from the Railway Station at Palapye.

Any person who drives a motor vehicle within any of the above-mentioned areas at a speed exceeding twenty miles an hour will be guilty of an offence and liable to the penalties provided in the aforesaid Proclamation.
