

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 28 OF 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the provisions of section *nineteen* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Tax Proclamation, 1932 (No. 1 of 1932) as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to reduce generally for the years ending on the 31st day of March, 1936, and 31st day of March, 1937, the tax payable under section *three* (1) of the said Proclamation to 15s. and the maximum tax payable under section *three* (3) of the said Proclamation to forty-five shillings.

Furthermore under and by virtue of the provisions of section *twenty* (1) of the aforesaid Proclamation, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to fix the proportion of the tax in respect of the years ending the 31st March, 1935, 31st March, 1936, and 31st March, 1937, which shall be paid over to the Fund known as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Fund, established under section *two* of Proclamation No. 47 of 1919, at one-third of the tax.
