

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 61 OF 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *five* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, No. 17 of 1925, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to define the following area within which large and small game, as specified in the Third and Fourth Schedules to the aforesaid Proclamation shall be protected for a period of one year from the 1st March, 1937:—

Area: The Crown Lands in the Bechuanaland Protectorate lying between the Molopo River and the 24th parallel of South Latitude, including also the area extending northwards from that parallel to South Latitude 22° 30' bounded on the east by the 21st meridian of East Longitude and on the west by the South West Africa-Bechuanaland Protectorate Border.
