

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 63 OF 1937.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following further amendments to the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 28 of 1926, as amended by High Commissioner's Notices No. 146 of 1933 and No. 18 of 1937:--

1. Regulation No. 55 is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "move" and the substitution therefor of the words "remove, cause to be removed or allow to be removed".
2. Regulation No. 56 is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "move or cause to be removed", and the substitution therefor of the words "remove, cause to be removed or allow to be removed".
3. Regulation No. 61 is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "moving or causing to be removed", and the substitution therefor of the words "removing, causing to be removed or allowing to be removed".
