### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Entitled the Public Holidays (Bechuanaland Protectorate)  
Amendment Proclamation, 1937.

Whereas it is expedient to amend further the Public Holidays (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1911 (No. 34 of 1911) hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Second Schedule to the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "(23rd day of June)" after the words "King's Birthday" and the substitution therefor of the words "(9th day of June)".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Public Holidays (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation 1937 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
