

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 27th August, 1937.)

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Appropriation
1937-38) Proclamation, 1937.

Whereas it is desirable to make provision out of the public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate for the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1938.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of the Bechuanaland Protectorate are hereby charged towards the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1938, with a sum of £224,226 (two hundred and twenty-four thousand two hundred and twenty-six pounds).

2. The moneys granted by this Proclamation shall be applied to the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule annexed hereto and more particularly specified in the Estimates of the Expenditure of the Protectorate for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1938, submitted to and approved by the Secretary of State for Dominions Affairs.

3. The moneys granted by the Proclamation shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent or purpose other than the particular services to which the said amounts have been granted respectively by this Proclamation.

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Appropriation (1937-38) Proclamation, 1937, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of April, 1937.
